

COMPETITION RULES "UNLEASH YOUR IMAGINATION"

§1. Definitions

1. **Competition** – a competition organized by the Organizers under the terms specified in the Rules. The Competition includes all activities of the Participants within the time and manner specified by the Organizers;
2. **Prize** – the University ensures the participation of the winning Participant in the production of a short film as a director, with production and financial support from the Television;
3. **Organizers:**
 1. **TVN S.A.**, headquartered in Warsaw at: ul. Wiertnicza 166, 02-952 Warsaw, registered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw, XIII Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under the KRS number: 0000213007, hereinafter referred to as "Television";
 2. **Warsaw Film School, Gdynia Film School, Lodz Film School, Krzysztof Kieslowski Film School at the University of Silesia, Aleksander Zelwerowicz Theatre Academy in Warsaw**, hereinafter collectively referred to as "Universities";
4. **Rules** – these competition rules;
5. **Participant** – an adult natural person with full legal capacity who is a student of one of the Universities and who has entered the Competition as the author/authors of a short film script;
6. **Winner or Winners** – Participant(s) who will be awarded the Prize.

§2. General Provisions

1. These Rules define the terms under which the Competition is conducted.
2. The Organizers of the Competition are the Universities and the Television.
3. The Universities are the entities promising the Prize within the meaning of Articles 919 and 921 of the Civil Code.
4. The Rules are available at the headquarters of the Organizers.

§3. Conditions of Participation

1. Only adult natural persons with full legal capacity who are students of one of the Universities may participate.
2. A short film script may have multiple authors.

3. To participate in the Competition, the Participant(s) must submit a short film script by April 20, 2025, to the address specified by the University at which the author(s) are currently students. A Participant may submit only one short film script, regardless of the number of Universities they are attending.
4. The short film script should be a maximum of 6 pages long, assuming that the short film should be approximately 7 minutes long.
5. Employees and associates of the Television and their family members may not participate in the Competition. Family members include ascendants, descendants, siblings, spouses, and persons in adoptive relationships.
6. A prerequisite for students of a given University to participate in the Competition is the signing of an agreement by the University with the Television by the start of Stage I, i.e., by June 30, 2025.
7. Participation in the Competition implies acceptance of the Rules.
8. By submitting a short film script, the Participant declares that: a) They are the author/co-author of the submitted script and hold exclusive and unrestricted copyright, assuming all legal responsibility and releasing the Competition Organizer from liability. b) They consent to its use for the production of a short film and its subsequent publication on the player.pl platform without receiving any author's fee.

§4. Competition Procedure

1. The Competition runs from March 1, 2025, to November 30, 2025.
2. The goal of the Competition is to select the Winner(s).
3. The Competition consists of three stages:

Stage I – until April 30, 2025: a) Each University selects up to 5 scripts submitted by its students. b) The selection is made by a 3-person jury composed of faculty members from each University. c) Selected scripts are sent by the Universities to the Television by April 30, 2025, with the University's emblem.

Stage II – April 30, 2025, to May 31, 2025: a) A 5-person jury from the Television selects up to 5 scripts from the 25 submitted. b) The Television jury consists of:

2. Pawel Maslona
3. Jan Holoubek
4. Bartlomiej Ignaciuk

5. Bartłomiej Kaczmarek c) Selection is based on artistic and production feasibility criteria.

Stage III – May 31, 2025, to November 30, 2025: a) By June 15, 2025, a pitching session and workshops will be held with the winning script authors at TVN XR Studio. b) From July 1, 2025, to September 30, 2025, short films based on the winning scripts will be produced. c) By October 31, 2025, internal review by the Television jury. d) By November 30, 2025, post-production will be finalized. e) In January 2026, a screening and premiere on player.pl will take place.

§5. TVN's Contribution to Production

1. TVN's contribution of 100,000 PLN includes: a) 70,000 PLN in production support:
 - One shooting day at TVN XR Studio with full supervision and consulting.
 - Rental of available filming equipment.
 - Assistance from camera and lighting professionals.
 - Support during post-production.
 - Catering and production support crew.
 - Music from TVN's database. b) Up to 30,000 PLN in financial investment for 3D environments, set design, actors, and transportation.

§6. Production Participation Conditions

1. The film budget must be approved by TVN.
2. The core student film crew must consist of current students.
3. All agreements must be signed and submitted to TVN at least a week before filming.
4. TVN will provide a detailed equipment list after competition results are announced.
5. Test sessions at TVN XR Studio will be available for up to three 4-hour sessions per project.
6. The shooting date must be booked at least three weeks in advance.

§7. Exclusion from the Competition

1. Organizers may immediately exclude a Participant in case of: a) Violation of the Rules; b) Violation of University regulations.
2. Exclusion of one author disqualifies the entire script.

§8-§9. Data Processing by Organizers and Television

- Personal data will be processed according to relevant privacy policies.

§10. Complaints Procedure

1. Complaints must be submitted in writing to the provided address or via email.
2. Complaints should include the Participant's full name, a description of the issue, and a specific request.
3. Complaints will be resolved within 14 days.
4. Participants will be informed of the decision via email or postal mail.

§11. Final Provisions

1. The Organizers reserve the right to amend the Rules with 3 days' notice.
2. Any disputes will be settled by the competent court.
3. Matters not covered by the Rules are governed by the Civil Code and other applicable Polish laws.
